ESOPHAGEAL MANOMETRY

Preparation Instructions

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NIGHT BEFORE PROCEDURE

Do **not eat or drink after midnight** until your procedure is completed.

DAY OF PROCEDURE

Medications that need to be taken regularly, such as **high blood pressure** and **heart medication**, can be taken with small sips of water up until 2 hours prior to the procedure.

Medications that are **not essential** should **not** be taken on the day of the procedure until after the manometry is completed. These medications include:

Pain medicines - such as Demerol, codeine, morphine, Percodan, Percocet

Sedatives or tranquilizers - such as Valium, Librax, Ativan, Elavil, Thorazine

Antispasmodics - such as Bentyl, Donnatal, Levsin, Robinul

Promotility agents - such as Reglan (metoclopramide), Zelnorm (tegaserod), erythromycin, Motilium (domperidone)
